The importance of the study of English needs hardly to be reemphasized in today's globalized world. In fact, the study of English opens doors to various careers such as teaching, research, journalism, civil service, banking, serving in NGOs etc.

At CIU English Department, we aim at shaping the spirit of our students so that they are well prepared to face the challenges of our times.

We follow a multidisciplinary program to ensure a balanced and holistic growth of our learners. Students here not only acquire knowledge of literatures in English but also become competent users of English – fluent in speaking, conversant in reading and articulate in writing.

Program Structure:

BA (Honours) in English offers a Liberal Arts Program with the following course structure and credits. Each course comprises of 3 credits.

Students usually take 4 courses in each term and earn 12 credits.

Admission Eligibility

- ◆ In order to be admitted into the BA (Honours), a student must have GPA 2.50 in both SSC and HSC examinations (5.00 in total). However, if the score is below 2.50 at any level, the student must have GPA 6.00, totaling the scores in SSC and HSC.
- For Freedom Fighters' wards with a total GPA of 5.00 in HSC and SSC may be also be admitted.
- ◆ 'O' Level in 5(Five) subjects and 'A' Level in 2(Two) subjects with minimum 'B' Grade in four subjects and 'C' Grade in three subjects.
- International Baccalaureate.
- ◆ High School Diploma (American model 10+2).
- Other 12 year programs must procure equivalence from the education board.

Currently, students get 50% tuition scholarships and a new student pays 29,000 BDT per term; the total fees for the full BA (Hons.) is 3,33,000 BDT.
