Admission Eligibility

Students require a 4-year BA in English for admission; however, students with Bachelors with Honours in subjects other than English may also be admitted but will require to earn additional 12 credits to be eligible for the degree.

MA in English Language Teaching (ELT):

MA in English Language Teaching program is designed to prepare competent teachers of English language and language teaching professionals like teacher trainers or language teaching managers. Courses will cover the various aspects of teaching/learning English language. Theoretical, practical as well as technology-based approaches to language teaching/learning will be taught. Two categories of courses-core and optional – will be offered. A student will also have to write a Thesis (3 credits) on a topic relevant to teaching/learning English language.
