Towhid Samad, an Honours Graduate and a Masters in Economics was elected Chairman of the Board of Trustees (BoT) 2014-2016 of Chittagong Independent University (CIU). Samad was elected to the office of the Chairman of the Education Scientific Technical Cultural Development Trust(ESTCDT), the Founding Trust of IUB and CIU, in the year 2004 and for a second term in June 2006. He was then elected Chairman of the Governing Council of Independent University, Bangladesh (IUB) in 2008 and was elected to the office of the newly constructed Board of Trustees of IUB under the Private Universities Act 2010, as the first Chairman.

Towhid Samad is the Chairman of the Bangladesh General Insurance Company (BGIC), the Savar Group and also the Managing Director of Holiday Publications Ltd. He was also elected and served as President, Dhaka Club Limited. He actively participated in the Liberation War and has the distinction of carrying the first catchment of weapons into Dhaka City in early April 1971.



Biography of

Dr. A. Majeed Khan

Dr. A. Majeed Khan, born in Faridpur in 1929, and educated in Kolkata, London, and Minnesota, has the distinction of being the first Ph.D recipient in Sociology and Anthropology from Bangladesh. He is a member of 'Phi Beta Kappa', the most prestigious honor society for promoting liberal arts and sciences in the United States, and was bestowed a 'Doctor of Humane Letters', a prominent honorary doctorate for advancing higher education, from Hamline University, St. Paul Minnmesota.

Dr Khan has held positions as a Distinguished Visiting Professor and Senior Fulbright Fellow at Hamline University, Minnesota and a Resident Fellow in the Department of Rural Sociology at the University of Wisconsin. He has also taught at universities in Holland, Sweden and Jordan.

Dr. Majeed Khan has served as an ambassador of Bangladesh to France, Spain and Morocco, a senior director of the United Nations Development Program, UNDP, a member of the Executive Board and Permanent Representative to the United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization, UNESCO, and a Cabinet Minister for Education and for Planning, among other departments, in Bangladesh, during the 1980s. He was decorated with the Officer de Fordre des Palmes Academiques by the Republic of France for his contributions to education, science and culture.

His exceptionally meritorious Service to the field of education and unparalleled vision was instrumental in the successful establishment of numerous institutes and organizations such as:

- The Academy for Rural Development in Comilla, Bangladesh in 1958 with Dr. Akhter Hamid Khan
- · The Department of Social Work at Rajshahi University in 1964,
- The Education, Science, Technology and Cultural Development Trust (ESTCDT), in 1991, which later established the first private university in Bangladesh: Independent University, Bangladesh, IUB, in 1993, and
- . The University of Information Technology and Sciences, UITS, in 2003, as its founder Vice Chancellor.

Dr. Khan spent seven years as President of Independent University, Bangladesh and under his able leadership, IUB solidified its status as one of the nation's leading private universities and emerged as a leader in the area of providing liberal arts education to the nation. He is also currently a board member of Chittagong Independent University.

To date, Dr. Majeed Khan has authored over 100 professional articles, monographs and book chapters and edited a compendium of biographies entitled Twenty Great Bengalies. Presently, he is engaged in co-editing the second edition of a collection of essays by distinguished authors and scholars, a reader on National Culture and Heritage, to be published by IUB.

Since 2009, Dr. Khan has been working with a group of like-minded scholars, scientists and social leaders to initiate and fast-track a movement for holistic economic development of an agro-based economy through research in biotechnology and synthetic biology. This initiative is now known as the Committee of Action for Research, Extension and Services-CARES, of which Dr. Khan is the current Executive Chairman. Recently, the Association of Universities of Asia and Pacific, AUAP, has elected Dr Majeed Khan a member of its Advisory Council.

Last year, Independent University, Bangladesh, conferred upon Dr, Khan the title and honor of President Emeritus in recognition of his selfless service and commitment to the development of higher education and for his determination, enthusiasm, and leadership in introducing the concept of private university education in Bangladesh.

Dr. Mahmud Hassan Assistant Professor of Chittagong Independent University participated in the American Marketing Association's (AMA) Summer Educators Conference 2014. This year's conference took place in San Francisco from 1-3rd August with the theme "Leveraging new technologies to create value for the customers and firms". Scholars from 45 different nations participated in the conference. Dr. Hassan's paper *Customer-to-customer helping behaviour and its implications to the marketers within brand communities of Facebook" was present in the Branding Track. The paper is co-authored with Dr. Simon Pervan; Associate professor and Director Research of Swinburne University Australia and Engr. Rashid Ahmed Chowdhury of CIU. The conference was a wonderful opportunity for Dr. Hassan to meet with the leading academics within marketing as many department heads and Deans of Business Schools in USA were present at the conference. Dr. Hassan who is also a member of AMA has been selected to work as a reviewer for the conference papers this year. Dr. Hassan also expressed his interest to open a AMA marketing club in CIU. Currently AMA only operates in North and South America but Matt Weingarden of AMA is given the responsibility to explore such possibilities with CIU. If initiated such a club will be first of its kind in Asia. Students taking part in the club will be allowed to participate in AMA conferences in USA and listen to acclaimed academics and industry experts through seminars, webinars and workshops. Furthermore, Dr. Hassan had a detailed discussion with Brandon Winter of Stukent. Stukent offers internet based marketing simulation course, digital textbooks and an educational platform that helps academia and students to gain hands on internet based



Dr. Mir Nurul Absar Nahid Joins School of Business, CIU

Dr. Mir Mohammed Nurul Absar Nahid recently joined School of Business, Chittagong Independent University as an Associate Professor. Dr. Nahid has been in university teaching for last 15 years in different roles in a number of universities including 4 years as Adjunct at IUB, Chittagong.

Dr. Nahid earned his PhD in HRM from University of Chittagong in 2010. He completed MBA and BBA from the same university.
Dr. Nahid completed post graduate diploma in HRM from Bangladesh Institute of Management in 2004 where he secured 2nd Position in National Merit List.

Dr. Nahid carried out post doctoral research under the prestigious 'Commonwealth-AMDISA' Fellowship at world famous Indian Institute of Management (IIM) and University Sains Malaysia (the lone APEX university). His post doctoral research topic was 'Human Capital Reporting in Emerging Economies'. A review article on the post doctoral study of Dr. Nahid was written by Dr. Azlan Amran, Deputy Dean, Graduate School of Business, University Sains Malaysia and subsequently published in AMDISA newsletter Vol. 25, January 2014.

Dr. Nahid has written around 30 articles/book chapters/ case/conference papers in reputed international and national journals indexed in / published by Scopus, SAGE, Inderscience, Emerald, JSTOR, ABDC, EconLit, Cabell's, ProQuest, and EBSCO. Dr. Nahid's research focuses on issues related to cross-national human capital reporting, intellectual capital, knowledge management, comparative HR in public and private sectors, and HR and organizational performance One of his latest papers on 'Human capital reporting in banking sector of Bangladesh' has been accepted for publication in the International Journal of Learning and Intellectual Capital', which is ranked as one the top ten journals of the world under 'Knowledge Management and Intellectual Capital' category. He is a reviewer of a number of international journals such as Management Research Review (Emerald), S A Journal of Global Business Research (Emerald), and Journal of Advances in Management Research (Emerald).

Dr. Nahid has been working as an Associate Editor (Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Afghanistan) of South Asian Journal of Human Resources Management published by SAGE, the world's 5th largest publisher of academic journals.

Dr. Nahid is a Fellow of Bangladesh Society for Human Resources Management and a Member of Society for HRM, USA.
